Realtime Collaborative Workspace

- Developing a realtime collaborative workspace application enabling multiple users to edit documents simultaneously with live synchronization, similar to Google Docs style collaboration but for coding.
- Implemented CRDT based **real time collaboration (YJS)** to ensure conflict free, low latency document editing across distributed clients.
- Integrated Hocuspocus server within a NestJS backend, enabling scalable WebSocket based real time communication.
- Implemented Monaco Editor integration with Yjs bindings, providing a powerful, IDE like editing experience.
- Implemented user registration with a free plan, providing default limited permissions to new users.
- Designed a room based collaboration system, allowing users to create rooms, invite others, and collaborate after invitation acceptance.
- Integrated Stripe for subscription management, enabling users to upgrade from **Free to Basic or Premium plans with higher limits**.
- Enforced plan based restrictions on room creation and participation, implementing NestJS Guards to prevent misuse and ensure authorization compliance.

Vehicle & Anti Theft Tracking Web App

- Developed GPS vehicle tracking and inventory management application currently live and actively used by automotive dealerships.
- Integrated map services and realtime data visualization to display vehicle movement, status updates, and historical routes.
- A single dealer using the platform for 4 months generated approximately **\$250,000** in device sales, proving real world commercial value and platform effectiveness.
- Implemented a **multi tenant architecture** enabling each dealer to securely access the application via a **dedicated subdomain**, ensuring data isolation and tenant level configuration.
